Junior Glee (Yrs 1,2,3,4)

These classes are an introduction to our Glee Clubs

If you have a creative and bubbly child who likes to express themselves or a more shy child who would like to build their confidence and explore their skills then Mini Glee Club is the place
Throughout the term the students will be guided through songs and drama games in order to develop skills and use the children's own energy to express themselves

Intermediate (Yrs 5&6,7)

The next step to Glee and Performing

Students continue to develop skills in Singing, Acting and Movement

They work towards performances and concerts to put into practice the skills they are learning
Students are used to the very best of their ability and time is taken to develop individual skill as well as a creative team dynamic

Senior Glee (Yrs 8,9,10,11)

These students are usually already training in one or two performance disciplines

A lot of emphasis is on working as a company and developing a professional attitude both on and off stage
All the skills in Singing, Acting and Movement are stretched to ensure the children are engaged and challenged

Pre Professional - Our Elite Glee Academy - Invitation Only - Years 10Up

These students are aged between 14 and 19, they are experienced and confident performers who excel in all areas of music and performance and continue to train both in Musical Theatre and Pop genres as well as gaining guidance from guest actors

The students are versatile as actors, singers and musicians with a professional attitude both on and off the stage.
Most performers have been with Mad Fish for a number of years and are a leading example to our younger performers. We do accept new members of a certain performance standard

WHAT IS FILM AND SCREEN SCHOOL

At Mad Fish Film and Screen School, students create and act in their own films, adverts and sketches in a fun, welcoming environment. Classes are led by an accomplished screen actor Sam Coleman with major tv & film credits including Game of Thrones, Leatherface and Lord of Chaos

Projects are filmed by a Mad Fish Film and Screen School alumni Alex who is now training professionally at Brighton Film School

Students will have the opportunity to learn professional acting and devising techniques specifically for TV and Film, understand industry standard terminology, and get practical, hands-on experience making and starring in films. Recent projects include 'Pizzapocalypse' – a comedy film about delivering pizza during a zombie apocalypse, 'Bouquet House' – An Edwardian upstairs/downstairs TV Pilot, and 'The Slough Department' – a 'The Office' style fly-on-the-wall mockumentary set in a fictional government department

In addition, at least once a year, students will have the opportunity to learn audition techniques, comedic acting skills and combat choreography. Alumni from our Film and Screen School have gone on to get professional acting jobs, been accepted into film production courses at University, and all have grown in confidence and ability since they started.
